Information for all courses supplied by Keens Truck Driver Training Bunbury in relation to the Issuance of Statements of Attainment

What is a Statement of Attainment?

Statements of Attainment are documents (like a certificate) that show the units of competency that a student completes as part of a nationally recognised course.

Moreover, A **statement of attainment** will only be issued if a learner successfully completes one or more units of competency or modules or an accredited short course, but does not meet the requirements for a qualification (as specified in the training package). The statement of attainment will list all of the units of competency or modules achieved. A record of results may also be issued.

- ➔ Statements of Attainment can ONLY be issued after you, the student, supplies Keens Driver Training with a valid USI (Unique Student Identifier). If you do not have one of these at the time of booking, you will be required to create one as soon as possible.

- ➔ The issuance of a Statement of Attainment does NOT guarantee that the student will gain a ticket or licence in the course that they have applied for, specifically:

"A Statement of Attainment is issued by a Registered Training Organisation when an individual has completed one or more accredited units"

Thus, all students will be issued with a Statement of Attainment irrespective of the outcome of their Practical Driving Assessment in the unit of:

- Drive heavy rigid vehicle
- Drive heavy combination vehicle
- Drive multi-combination vehicle;

Or the issue of their Practical Assessment in the unit of:

- Licence to operate a forklift truck
- Conduct civil construction skid-steer loader operations
- Conduct civil construction front end loader operations

To re-iterate, the issuance of a Statement of Attainment, does not guarantee that the student gains a ticket or licence in the course they have applied and sat for. It is not a licence. It is a certificate issued upon successfully completing a Unit of Competency only.
